- U.S. reciprocal tariffs go into effect April 5th for China and listed 10% countries
- All other countries go into effect April 9th
- De minimis eliminated for China & Hong Kong effective May 2nd, previously \$800
 - Postal items < \$800 have a flat duty of 30% of the value or \$25/item (moves to \$50/item June 1st)
- All tariffs on North American countries (Canada & Mexico) apply only to noncompliant USMCA goods
- 25% on automobiles (non-USMCA) effective April 3rd for all countries
- China has announced retaliatory tariffs on the U.S. of 125% effective April 12th
- Canada has announced a tariff of 25% on non-USMCA fully assembled vehicles and U.S. content
- EU has delayed 25% retaliatory tariffs on U.S. goods for 90 days
